Dear Reader,

As from 01 September 2018 Uniport will stop the handling of transport documents following the standard procedure (RTO-code NT1). As from 01 September 2018 you will only be able to collect containers with the transport documents according to the simplified procedure (RTO-code: MRN).

As from 01 September 2018 it will therefore not be possible to use the pre-announcement tool of the Portbase-Service for the Announcement Import Documentation and/or Transit declaration for NT-1 documents at Uniport. The web portal of Uniport will also not support the NT-1 code as from 01 September onwards.

Note!: For pre-announcing and subsequently the pick-up of containers you will require to have an Authorisation for the status of authorised consignor in which the terminal Uniport is mentioned as location of departure. In case your party does not have Authorisation for the status of authorised consignor as yet, please contact local customs as soon as possible. In case that you already have a valid Authorisation for the status of authorised consignor in place but without the location of departure mentioned as Uniport Multipurpose Terminals, Terminal quay 5, 6 & 7 Waalhaven, please arrange with local customs that location of departure Uniport is added in your current licence.

Trust to have informed you with the above write-up to ensure you can accommodate required changes on your side prior 01 September 2018.
